### Full Membership

Full members must be engaged in economic development and must be an individual. Groups can qualify under the “Organization” category.

### Associate Membership

An Associate member must be an individual

Qualify
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Municipal, provincial or federal government</li> <li>➤ Private Business / Private Consultant / Contractor</li> <li>➤ Public Bank or Financial Institution</li> <li>➤ Agencies &amp; organizations</li> <li>➤ Associations like <i>Alberta Chamber of Commerce</i> unless it complies with full membership criteria</li> <li>➤ Friendship Centres</li> </ul>

## Student Membership

To be eligible to become a Student member, an individual must be enrolled in one of the following fields of study: **Business Administration/Economics, Business Finance, Business Management, Natural Resources, and/or Community Economic Development.**

**Note:** If one is a student as well as practicing EDO, he/she can have an option of taking a **Full Membership** instead of a **Student** membership, and consequently have voting rights.

**Conversely:** If a Student member would like to run for the CANDO Student Board position, he/she must provide proof in the form of a student card issued by their educational institution stating that they are enrolled in one of the qualified fields of study.
